Believe it or not, we are entering the last six weeks of our 2018 – 2019 school year; however, we are not slowing down with our learning or great activities planned here at Raymond Case Elementary School. CAASPP testing, end of the year assessments, Raymond Case Olympics and other activities are all highlights coming up in the next month.

Our students in grades 3 – 6, will be taking the California Assessment of Student Proficiency and Progress (CAASPP) in both English/Language Arts and Mathematics. Parents can really help their child be successful with testing to encourage them to do their best, get extra sleep during testing, eat a healthy breakfast and arrive to school early. Our testing schedule is as follows:

- 3rd Grade - English/Language Arts – May 7th, May 9th
Math – May 21st, May 23rd
- 4th Grade - English/Language Arts – May 6th, May 8th
Math – May 20th, May 22nd
- 5th Grade - English/Language Arts – May 1st-2nd
Math – May 15th-16th
- 6th Grade - English/Language Arts – May 13th-14th
Math – May 29th-30th

*Please do not schedule appointments for your child when they are testing.

Parents will be receiving scores for their child sometime during the summer. Our students and teachers have noticed the strong rigor of this test and how our students were well prepared. Our 5th graders will be taking a Science portion of the CAASPP mid-May and finalize the California Physical Fitness testing with Mr. Allen by the end of May.



Thank you for your continued support for our students and our school programs at Raymond Case Elementary School.


