The Elk Grove Unified School District Facility Master Plan identifies up to \$31.5 million of facilities improvement needs at James Rutter Middle School over the next ten years.

To address these needs, and facilities needs identified across the District, a school facilities bond, Measure M, has been placed on the November 2016 ballot. If Measure M is approved by the voters, the proceeds will be used to upgrade and modernize facilities to provide 21st Century learning environments at all schools.

Other priorities identified at James Rutter Middle School:

- Modernize classroom features to current District standards
- Major building systems upgrades including heating and air conditioning, roofing and alarms or intercom
- Security measures including camera systems and fencing
- Technology improvements
- Outdoor seating and shade structures
- Gymnasium improvement
- Restroom renovations
- Drinking fountains
- Sidewalks
- Hardcourt improvements
- Track and field facilities renovations
- Interior and exterior paint
- Carpeting and flooring improvements

Project priorities will be determined by the Board of Education. Approval of Measure M does not guarantee all needed improvements will be completed due to the unpredictable nature of construction costs and the uncertainty of State and developer mitigation funding sources.
