Chapter Essential Question: How can you tell time and use measurement to describe the size of something?

1. Analog Clock—A device for measuring time by moving hands around a circle for showing hours, minutes, and sometimes seconds.
2. Digital Clock—A clock that shows time to the minute using digits.
3. Half Hour—30 minutes
4. Hour—A unit used to measure time in one hour, the hour hand on a clock moves from one number to the next.
5. Quarter Hour—15 minutes.
6. A.M.—The hours between midnight and noon.
7. Midnight—12:00 at night.
8. Noon—12:00 in the day.
9. P.M.—The hours between noon and midnight.
10. Elapsed Time—The amount of time that passes from the start of an activity to the end of that activity.
11. Liquid Volume—The amount of liquid in a container.
12. Liter—A metric unit for measuring capacity.
13. Gram—A metric unit that is used to measure mass. 
14. Kilogram—A metric unit for measuring mass. 1 Kilogram = 1,000 grams
15. Mass—The amount of matter in an object.
