- 1. <u>Analog Clock</u>—A device for measuring time by moving hands around a circle for showing hours, minutes, and sometimes seconds.
- 2. Digital Clock—A clock that shows time to the minute using digits.
- 3. Half Hour-30 minutes
- 4. Hour—A unit used to measure time in one hour, the hour hand on a clock moves from one number to the next.
- 5. Quarter Hour 15 minutes.
- 6. A.M. The hours between midnight and noon.
- 7. Midnight-12:00 at night.
- 8. Noon-12:00 in the day.
- 9. P.M. The hours between noon and midnight.
- 10. ELapsed Time—The amount of time that passes from the start of an activity to the end of that activity.
- II. Liquid Volume—The amount of Liquid in a container.
- 12. Liter—A metric unit for measuring capacity.
- 13. Gram-A metric unit that is used to measure mass.
- 14. Kilogram-A metric unit for measuring mass. 1 Kilogram= 1,000 grams
- 15. Mass—The amount of matter in an object.
