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Beginning Theatre Courses:

Theatre I (10 credits)— The Theater I course is designed to teach basic theater skills. Topics covered include: pantomime and movement, improvisation, script analysis, script writing, and performance basics. Theatre I is a prerequisite for all other advanced theater courses.

Children's Theatre (5 credits)— This class is a survey course similar to Theater I with a focus on performance for young audiences. Children's Theatre emphasizes musical theater instruction in addition to basic theater skills.

Drama Productions I (5 units)— This course focuses on the production aspect of plays. Students will analyze plays to determine appropriate set design, costuming, lighting, and make up. Activities in Drama Productions I include: scale drawing and model design, script analysis, and basic design concepts.
